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CLUB RULES ON REVERSE

St Catherine's 100 Club Rules

1. Name The Club shall be known as the **St Catherine's 100 Club** ("the Club").

2. Purpose:

The Parish 100 Club is run by St Catherine's Catholic Church, Wimborne to raise funds initially to support the refurbishment project in the church and hall. If, for some good reason, the project does not go ahead as currently planned, or if we raise more than we need, the remaining appeal funds will be used for the general charitable purposes of the parish. St Catherine's Catholic Church, Wimborne is part of the Diocese of Plymouth, (Plymouth Diocesan Trust), registered charity no 213227

3. Management

1. The Club will be administered by the **Parish Fundraising Committee**, appointed by the Parish Priest
2. The Committee will ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations.
3. The Committee will oversee membership records, draws, banking, and prize distribution.
4. The Parish Priest's decision in all matters relating to the Club shall be final.

4. Membership

5. Membership is open to any individual aged 18 or over.
6. Each member must complete a membership application form and set up a standing order of £10 per month per ticket.
7. There is no limit to the number of tickets any individual may hold.
8. Each ticket will be allocated a unique number, which will remain with the member for as long as their payments are up to date.
9. Members may join at any time, subject to availability and at the discretion of the Committee.

5. Payment

10. Payment must be made **by standing order** in the month preceding the draw.
11. Each £10 standing order entitles the member to one entry (ticket) in the following month's draw.
12. Members whose payments are not received by the due date will **not be entered** into that month's draw.
13. Payments received late will be entered into the **next available draw**.

6. Draws

14. A monthly draw will take place after a parish event
15. The draw will be made in public—typically after a church service or parish event—or witnessed by at least two independent parish representatives.
16. Each draw will produce three winning numbers:
 1. 1st Prize: £200
 2. 2nd Prize: £75
 3. 3rd Prize: £25
17. The draw results will be announced after a parish event and published in the Parish Newsletter / Website / Noticeboard.

7. Prizes

18. Prizes will be paid by cheque or bank transfer to the winners.
19. The remaining proceeds will be donated to [Parish Fund / Designated Cause].
20. In the event that the number of members or total income changes significantly, the Committee reserves the right to amend prize values, subject to notice being given to all members.

8. Accounts and Use of Funds

21. The Club's funds shall be held in the parish bank account under the control of the Parish Priest.
22. A record of income expenditure and prize payments will be maintained.
23. The Club will be run as a small society lottery under the Gambling Act 2005 and will comply with relevant registration requirements with the local authority if applicable.

9. Termination or Changes

24. The Parish Priest reserves the right to alter or suspend the operation of the Club if necessary (e.g., insufficient membership, legal or financial reasons).
25. Members will be given at least **one month's notice** of any changes to rules, prizes, or draw frequency.

10. Data Protection

26. Your details will be stored securely and used only for Parish 100 Club administration and in keeping with Plymouth Diocese Privacy Notice available online

11. Acceptance of Rules

Joining the Club and submitting a standing order will be deemed as acceptance of these rules.
